Sub: Reservation of storage space as per revised capacity-reg

Sir/Madam,

In respect of reassessment of capacity and 'over & above' capacity utilization in CWC godowns, CWC vide letter dated 12.04.2021(copy enclosed) has informed that they have revised the capacity of conventional godowns pan India level and are in the process of revising the storage rates also.

In this regard, it is informed that the matter has been examined in consultation with Finance Division of Hqrs and accordingly, following actions are instructed:

- I. All the General Managers(R)/ ED (Zones) will ensure reservation of Storage capacity of CWC and SWC on the basis of reassessment w.e.f. 01.04.2021.
- II. FCI Regions shall inspect and verify the reassessed capacities offered by CWC/SWC before hiring of the capacity.
- III. Every effort should be made to utilize the godown as per reassessed capacity.
- IV. Storage charges to be paid to CWC by FCI for the year 2021-22 onwards shall be decided on the basis of reassessed capacity. Till then payments to be regulated as per the existing capacity.

This is for information and necessary actions please.

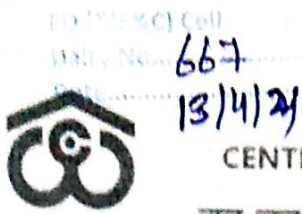

**Sub: Reservation for storage space as per revised capacity**

- Ref.: (i) Secretary, F&PD, letter no. 16-04/2017-Stg.III (334042) dated 06.04.2021  
(ii) FCI letter no. E.4(20)/2000/Stg.VII/Vol.I/Pt file dated 24.03.2021  
(iii) Ministry of CA, Food & Public Distribution Om No. 22-8/2020-FC-I dated 16.03.2021 containing the minutes of the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Secy. DFPD on 05.03.2021 to review the payment of storage charges to CWC/SWC and FCI for the stocks stored over and above the rented capacity.

Vide references above, the Ministry and FCI have communicated to assess and revise food grain storage capacity considering 174 MT per stack, wherever feasible. Ministry has also issued instruction regarding banning of use of Covered And Plinth (CAP) open storage.

Aforesaid directives have far reaching consequences. All warehouse service providers (CWC, SWC, FCI, other Govt. body, etc, shall have to upwardly revise capacity of conventional godowns, suitable for storage of wheat & rice.

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In compliance to the above, CWC has revised the capacity of its godowns PAN India level. A copy of the revised capacities is enclosed. CWC is also in process of revising published tariff w.e.f. 1.4.2021, considering current market conditions and factors related to 174 MTC per stack. The revised published storage charges will be lower than published rates, issued earlier which was fixed considering 140MTC per stack.

In view of above, CWC request as under:

- i. FCI and SCSC are requested to instruct their field formations to confirm their guaranteed reservation of storage space w.e.f. 01.04.21, as per the revised capacity of conventional godowns, foreclosing earlier/current reservations (pre-revised norms). **This will help to avail benefits of lower storage charges per bag per month.**
- ii. SWCs are requested to revise capacity of conventional godowns, considering 174 MT capacity per stack. Regional Managers of CWC have been asked to make the subject matter clear in this respect to their counterpart in the SWCs.
- iii. All old storage bills (upto 31<sup>st</sup> March'2021) may please be got settled early as per the Ministry approved rates.



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- iv. CWC has approached Ministry and FCI to approve new storage charges. Once approved, storage charges will be settled as per the revised published rates, as applicable to various depositors, i.e. farmers, cooperatives, FCI, SCSC, NAFED, and others, subject to conditions of reservations, like, minimum one year or AUB (Actual Utilization Basis), etc. CWC will shortly issue the revised published rates for storage of wheat and rice in its Central Warehouses PAN India level.
